TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This license is valid for a period of **12 months** from the date of issue.
2. The operator is licensed to own/operate an incineration Plant.
3. Without prejudice to the other conditions of this license, the licensee shall implement and maintain an environmental management system, organizational structure and allocate resources that are sufficient to achieve compliance with the requirements and conditions of this license.
4. The Authority shall reserve the right to withdraw, cancel or vary this license in the event of breach of any of the conditions stated herein or any contravention to the Environmental Management and Coordination Act (EMCA), CAP 387 and the Regulations thereunder.
5. The licensee shall keep environmental compliance records and reports, and shall make them available to the Environmental Inspectors upon demand.
6. The licensee shall ensure that competent personnel operate the facility.
7. The licensee shall ensure that staff and visitors are provided with appropriate personnel protective equipment (PPE).
8. The licensee shall give access to Environmental inspectors from the Authority without prior notice upon identification and provide information, reports, records and data for inspection.
9. The licensee shall provide the staff and visitors with full disclosure of the characteristics of the wastes being handled.
10. The licensee shall put appropriate signage and labeling on the facility.
11. The licensee shall ensure that the facility is designed and operated in a manner to prevent the occurrence of odour or other forms of health hazards.
12. The licensee shall provide adequate storage space for the wastes being managed at the facility.
13. The licensee shall provide adequate and effective control measures for fire, incidents and other nuisances.
14. The licensee shall ensure that the approved Environmental Management plan (EMP) is adhered to throughout the operational cycle.
15. The licensee shall ensure that a copy of this license is kept at the site at all times throughout the operational period
16. The licensee shall carry out Environmental Audits as required under EMCA CAP 387; and shall provide proof of submission of the Environmental Audit at renewal of the license.
17. The licensee shall ensure that the facility does not receive or handle materials from vandalized infrastructure.
18. The licensee shall comply with NEMA improvement orders throughout the operational period
19. The licensee shall seek written approval from the Authority for any operational changes.
20. The licensee shall notify the Authority of intention to decommission and submit a Decommissioning Plan for prior approval.
